# Rice Sentenced To 12.5 Years

A 20-year-old Gold Canyon woman was sentenced to 12.5 years in prison on a charge of second-degree murder in connection with the 2008 stabbing death of Randall Davis-Mercier.

According to officials, Mae ghan Rice, when she was 16, conspired with David Paulson, then 17 and one of her boyfriends, to kill Mercier out of jealousy.

died. Rice pled to second degree murder and cooperated with authorities.

Paulson is scheduled to be sentenced at 1:30 p.m. Monday, Sept. 12, in front stabbed Mercier 20 times be-extradited.
